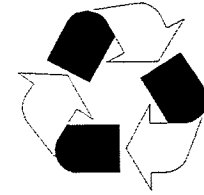


GLENWOOD CITY RECYCLING CENTER



There is a \$10.00 per month Recycle fee which will be billed quarterly with Utility Billing.

Items accepted for an additional fee:

\$50.00—Sectional couch

\$40.00 - Couch, king size mattress or box spring

\$30.00 - Recliner, love seat, office chair, upholstered chair, dining room table or chairs (each), queen size mattress or box spring

\$20.00 - Toilet, carpet, carpet pad (per room), full, twin or crib size mattress or box spring, bath tubs, dresser, rubber/plastic bumper cover

\$10.00 - Gas and charcoal grill, coffee or end table, vanities, high chair, sinks, ironing board, steel door

Tires

14" - 19"- \$8.00

20" - 24"- \$10.00

The recycling facility cannot accept appliances, electronics of any kind, construction debris or hazardous materials. **This is not an all-inclusive list. Check with recycling attendant before depositing items not listed. Do NOT leave items in the fenced in area.**

Items accepted:

Glass: Clear and brown. No window glass or mirrors. Metal caps, rings or foil must be removed and bottles must be reasonably clean.

Aluminum cans: Can be either whole or crushed.

Tin Cans (bi-metal): Can be whole or crushed and reasonably clean. Labels need not be removed.

Cardboard: Corrugated only.

Paper/Newspaper: All residential paper including magazines and newspaper are accepted. Paper needs to be removed from plastic bags before depositing in trailer. Paper needs to be separated: newspaper; office paper; all other paper.

Plastic: PETE (#1) and HDPE (#2) are accepted. These numbers can be found on the bottom of the container. Caps must be removed and containers reasonably clean.

Burn site:

The burn site is located at 1319 320th St by the City lagoons. A key is required to be checked out to access the burn site. Keys are available from the recycling center attendant during normal recycling center hours or from City Hall Monday - Friday 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Sticks, twigs, brush and clean wood (free from nails, screws and other hardware) are accepted. Per DNR regulations, no plywood, painted, stained, varnished, or treated lumber is accepted.

Compost site:

The compost site is located on Glen Meadows Lane. A key is required to be checked out to access the compost site. Keys are available from the recycling center attendant during normal recycling center hours or from City Hall Monday - Friday 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Leaves, grass clippings, clean fill and mulch are accepted. All material must be removed from bags.
